AMBASSADOR OF THE CLINTON SPRING FAIR COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Official entry forms to be received by May 17, 2024 except by special permission of the Huron Central Agricultural Society, which must be obtained in writing prior to the above mentioned date.
2. Ambassador of the Fair Competition participants must be 17 years of age by August 1, 2024. Junior Ambassadors age 13-16 years of age.
3. Participants will be disqualified immediately if their qualifications are found to be in contravention of any of the competition regulations herein set out and may also be disqualified and required to withdraw immediately if they fail to observe any of the instructions and regulations which may be set out by the supervising official of the competition.
4. Participants will be interviewed privately and judged by a panel of 3 judges at the Libro Hall, Central Huron Community Center, for approximately 7 minutes. Each participant is also expected to deliver a 3 minute public speech and each is required to participate in a brief impromptu question (30-60 seconds). The speech topics to be on Your Community, the Fair or Agricultural in Huron County. The judges will decide on the winner on the basis of community knowledge and involvement, knowledge of the Clinton Spring Fair, personality and presentation.
5. The winner of the Huron Central Agricultural Society Ambassador of the Fair Competition will help with the events at our fair, and local fairs. To attend the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies convention in Toronto February 2025. To participate in the District 8 Competition (the first Saturday in May 2025) AND the Ambassador of the Fairs at the Canadian National Exhibition Competition the 3rd weekend in August 2025.
6. The chosen Ambassador of the Fair, First and Second Runners-Up representing the Huron Central Agricultural Society cannot participate in another Ambassador of the Fair Competition in the same year.
